



Let's make a...

“Let Your Dreams Soar!” Kite For Your Dolls

Materials:

- ✓ Kite Template, printed on regular 20 -28 lb paper
- ✓ Scissors
- ✓ Pipe cleaner with fuzz trimmed, or other craft wire
- ✓ Card Stock
- ✓ Glue
- ✓ Wooden skewer or thin dowel
- ✓ 5 - 6 inch length of thin string for tail
- ✓ Tissue Paper

Instructions:

1. Print templates, and cut out pieces.
2. Cut thin strips of card stock and glue to the kite to simulate a "cross" shaped kite frame.
3. Glue one end of string to the bottom point of the kite.
4. Twist 5 small rectangles of tissue paper to make "bows", and attach to the kite's tail.
5. Cut skewer to a length of approximately 1 inch.
6. Wrap one end of the pipe cleaner around the wooden skewer two or three times.
7. Poke the other end of the pipe cleaner into the center of the kite's "cross" and glue in place. (A hot glue gun works best for this step)



Get Creative!

You can also use any pretty paper or other printed designs for your kite design!

Now you can nicely tell your doll to go fly a kite!

Happy Landings!

If you'd like to have your doll hold the kite instead of flying it, you can replace the pipe cleaner with string.
